BTC opens for its first local group, EMMC

- Spanish Lookout, this weekend June 4-6. Thereafter, we have another small local group of 20 persons for next weekend June 10-12, and lastly, a small US group of 9 from FBC Elba NY, June 21-28.

Local summer camp groups for July are only tentatively booked due to current covid19 restrictions in place. Due to this, we have incorporated some guidelines for groups staying with us.

- •Belize still has mask mandates and curfews.
- •Also keep in mind BTC is not a GOLD STAR resort.
- •Both local and when allowed foreign groups can only book for 50% max capacity (Up to 60 persons only) to be able to maintain social distance. Suggested small groups only.
- •All foreign group members must provide proof of Covid19 immunization.
- •Or a negative PCR testing before arriving and upon leaving.
